We wish to remind you that St. Vincent de Paul is an Arizona Qualified Charitable Organization (QCO). Donations can be deducted dollar for dollar on your Arizona Personal Income Tax Return.

The maximum QCR credit donation amount for 2025 is \$495 single filer or \$987 married filing jointly.

There is no minimum.

AZ law allows QCO donations made from 1/1/2026 through 4/15/26 to be claimed on the 2025 income tax return using AZ Form 321.
