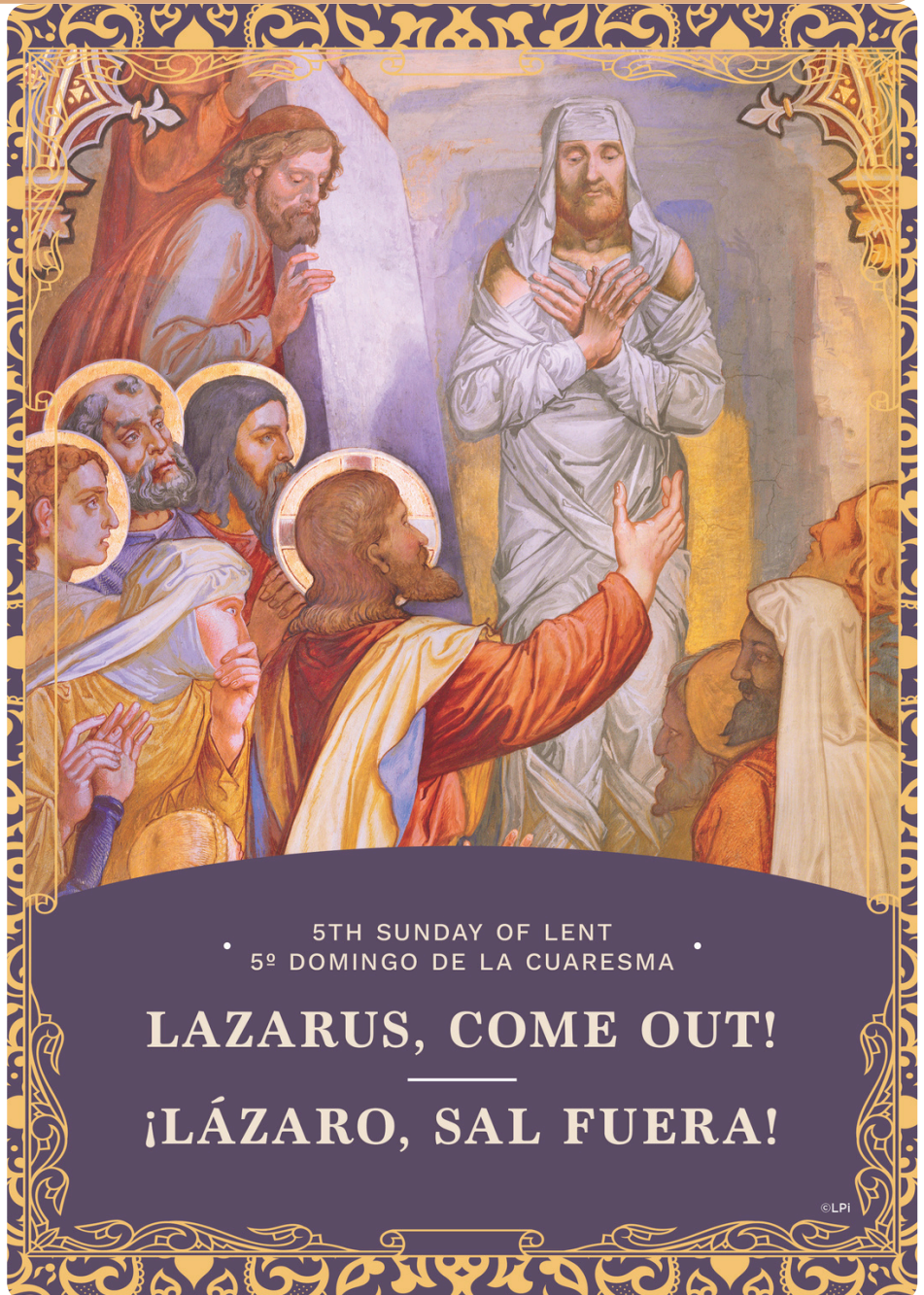

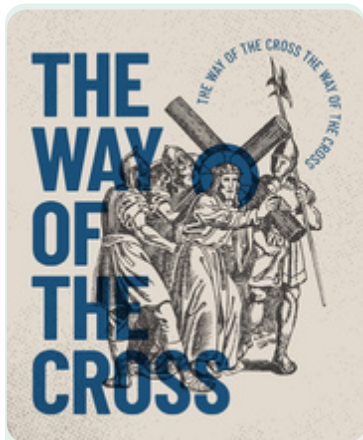

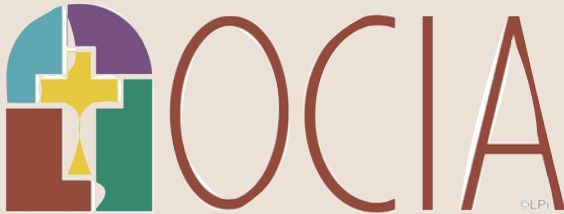
Registration for the 2025-2026 Religious Education session **has ended.**
