Fish fry dinner includes cod, fries, coleslaw, and a beverage. Ticket price is \$15 for adults. \$5 for children under 10.

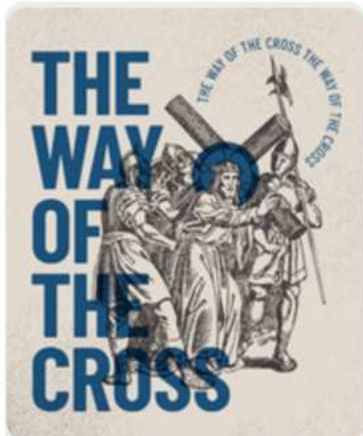
Pre-sale tickets are available at each weekend Mass.

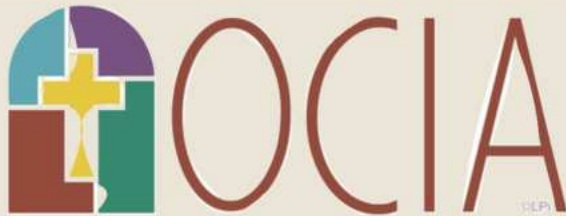
Registration for the 2025-2026 Religious Education session **has ended.**
